This carbine was issued to the **North West Mounted Police** {NWMP}. It was part of order number 20202, which consisted of 300 carbines shipped on April 20, 1885.

On charge of Constable C.E. DIXON<sup>1</sup> of "F" Division<sup>2</sup> {Prince Albert} in January 1887.

On charge to "F" Division {Prince Albert} on February 10, 1894.

On charge to "F" Division {Prince Albert} on April 7, 1897.
