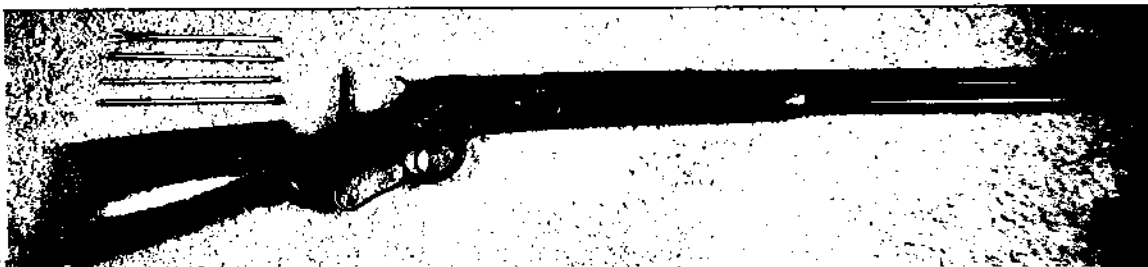

SERIAL NUMBER: 69336
CALIBER: .45-90
BARREL: 22 inch, octagon, EXTRA HEAVY
SIGHTS: Lyman tang & rear; Beach front
MAGAZINE: Full
STOCK & BUTT PLATE: Checkered pistol grip, crescent butt plate; cleaning rod in butt.
RECEIVER: Case hardened
TRIGGER: Single set trigger
SPECIAL FEATURES: 22 inch, extra heavy barrel, set trigger, special sights, special order 13 inch pull stock, provision for cleaning rod in butt. Accompanied by factory letter of authenticity.

CONDITION:

Barrel retains 85% blue with two small spots of discoloration. Magazine has mostly gray/brown patina with traces of blue. Receiver has overall darkened, nickered appearance. Bore is bright, in very good to fine condition. 2X wood has minor dings and nicks with 85% original finish intact; overall very fine condition. All matching serial numbers and original parts.

SPECIAL NOTE: Model 1886 rifles with shorter than standard, extra heavy barrels are extremely rare. Only 21 are shown in factory ledgers. When combined with the deluxe wood, special order short pull stock, and provision for cleaning rod in the butt, this rifle is probably unique, as configured.
