
Based on the information you provided and our review, we determined that our Branch previously examined the following firearm in August 1991 and removed it from NFA provisions:

Winchester Model 1894 carbine, caliber .30 W.C.F., serial number 885127, with factory-fitted, 15-inch barrel.

We further determined the above firearm to be a "curio or relic."
