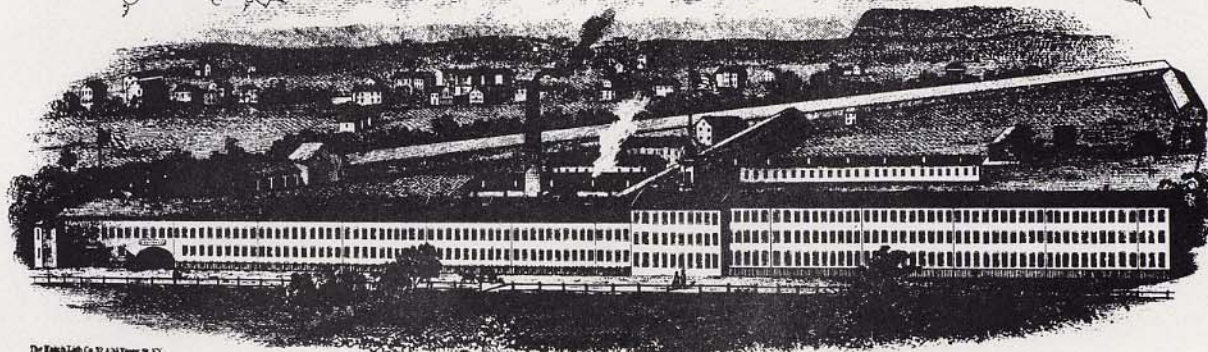

It has been our pleasure to build this Custom Timber Carbine, WINCHESTER Model 94 for you. All individual special features are listed below for any future reference.

MODEL NO. 94AE GRADE Custom Timber Carbine SERIAL NO. RLK1

METAL FINISH High lustre blue CALIBER 444 Marlin

BARREL LENGTH 17" factory chrome-moly tapered round barrel.

STOCK Full fancy American black walnut, pistol grip buttstock with matching long nose forearm – satin polyurethane finish – 1/2" black "Winchester" recoil pad.

STYLE OF CHECKERNG Machine cut "Point" pattern – 18 L.P.I.

ENGRAVING Rifle to include delicate scroll engraving on barrel band, lower link, finger lever and lower tang. This rifle was in the presents of George Madis for engraving at the time of his passing in December 2003. Even though the rifle was never completed it was requested by the customer "Robert Kassab" for it to be completed as is. This is the last "Winchester" rifle that was engraved by George Madis for the Winchester Custom Shop.

FEATURES Hand honed action – angle eject receiver – hammer block and cross bolt safety – hand lead lapped barrel – Lyman flip up rear sight with ramped front sight complete with hood – barrel ported – Special Custom Shop Proof Stamp on barrel along with Winchester Proof Stamp – three quarter length magazine tube – drilled and tapped for Lyman aperture sight – hand engine turned extractor, locking block, elevator and cartridge guides.

We hope you experience many years of enjoyment from this special Custom made Winchester.
