In 1914, Marlin offered to its dealers "10 Model 1894 Carbines, .44-40, 15-inch barrel, overrun from large lot made for Mounted Police of Chile, with their inscription on top of frame in small letters, \$10.00". Based on the exceptionally fine condition, especially compared to other specimens with these same markings, we believe this is one of those 10 carbines that never made it to Chile.
